Following is the admission criteria to these programmes.

#### Results Of Spring Semester 2003

23<sup>rd</sup> Jan 2004

Results of spring semester 2003 will be announced on 6-8-2003. Following scheme of letter grades and grade points will be adopted.

#### Marks, Grade Points, Grades Letters

The students would be rated on grades A, B+, B, C+, C, D+ D and grade F. The letter grades and their numerical equivalence are given as under: -

80% and above	Α	4.0
75-79.5%	B+	3.5
70-74.5%	В	3.0
65-69.5%	C+	2.5
60-64.5%	C	2.0
55-59.5%	-D+	1.5
50-54.5%	D	1.0
Below 50%	F	0.0

The fractions in marks equal or higher than 0.5 shall be rounded up to one.

A student scoring a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 0.8 and above but less than 1.5 in a semester shall be promoted on probation for a maximum of three semesters, to improve his/her CGPA to 1.5.

He/she shall however, not be allowed to continue his/her study

if he/she fails to improve his/her CGPA average to the required level of 1.5 before the expiry of this period. A student securing CGPA less than 0.8 at any time during his/her program of study shall cease to be the student of the University.

- The student eligible to continue the study program and having failed in the course(s) shall repeat the course(s) whenever such course(s) shall be offered by the Faculty of Computer and Emerging Sciences.
- A student shall have to complete the BS Program within (10) semesters or Five years, but he/she shall not be allowed to avail more than two chances in each course.

## BS (Computer Science) and BS (Mathematics)

- F Sc Pre-Engineering examination with Physics and Mathematics securing at least 50% marks in aggregate.
- Intermediate with Mathematics securing at least 50% marks in aggregate
- Any other examination of a foreign university / Institution/ Examining Body equivalent to the higher secondary school certificate (Pre-engineering).

Equivalence and percentage of marks will be determined by IBCC

• Diploma of - Associate Engineering Examination Securing at least 60% aggregate marks. Not more than 10% of the admitted students should belong to this category.

### BS (Computer Engineering) and BS (Electronics)

 F Sc Pre-Engineering examination with Physics and Mathematics securing at

- least 50% marks in aggregate.
- Any other examination of a foreign university / Institution/ Examining Body equivalent to the higher secondary school certificate (Pre-engineering).

Equivalence and percer of marks will be detended by IBCC.

• Diploma of Associate Engineering Examination Securing at least 60% aggregate marks. Not more than 10% of the admitted students should belong to this category.

Merit would be determined as per following scheme.

Matriculation 20%

Test +Interview 25%+ 5%
