ntelligentsia has done well during first fifty years of our existence as an independent nation. Excellent books have been written on history, literature, poetry, politics, humour, religion etc. Mushtaq Ahmed Yousafi, Ibn-e-Insha, Syed Zamir Jaffery, Qudrutullh Shahab, Mumtaz Mufti, Mukhtar Masood, Intizar Hussain and Atta Shad are few names from the long list of authors of excellent caliber. Is our new generation aware of their contributions?

Following questions were put to 50 undergraduate students. How many of them spare time for reading material other than textbooks? What type of books do they read? How many of them go through national and international newspapers and journals regularly? How many are used to read a book before going to bed?

Only seven of them were readers of other than textbook material. One was reader of material on Philosophy of Islam. There were three who read a national English daily or an international weekly magazine. Most of them were browsers of daily Urdu news papers. However none of them was aware of classics like Shahab Nama, Loh-e-Ayam, Awaz-e Dost, Moj-e-Kausar, Aabe-Gum, Alakh Nagari or Udas Naslien.

It is worrisome that new generation has little awareness about such a treasure. Lack of good libraries may be one of the reasons. There was a good library in every street of Quetta two decades ago. Now there are internet cafes instead. It is true that access to knowledge is extremely fast via internet, but libraries have their own role. Pleasure of reading a book is completely different from excitement of scrolling a document on the monitor. We should build our libraries, link them through internet and make information about in -stock books available to readers.

Balochistan University of Information Technology and Management Sciences is committed in building of good reading habits of its students. Establishment of a good library, housing Urdu and English classics in addition to technical books is our goal. Linkage to other libraries via internet is the next step. We are striving for making our library facilities available to students of other universities on reciprocal

First meeting of Coordination Council

The first meeting of Coordination Council for universities in Balochistan was held in the Governor's House on 18-09-2003 at 1.00 p.m. Honourable Governor of Balochistan Mr. Owais Ghani chaired the meeting. Vice Chancellors of three public sector universities of Balochistan attended this meeting with their teams. Team of Balochistan University of Information Technology & Management Sciences Comprised of Dr Mohammad Abbas Chaudhary, Vice Chancellor, Dr Mohammad Hussain, Dr Sabir Hussain Usmani and Dr Mohammad Nawaz.

Honourable Governor of Balochistan said "The Federal Ministry of Education has announced several schemes for promotion of higher education and Dr Atta ur Rehman, Adviser to President for Science and Technology has special consideration for Balochistan in this respect. He stressed that it is responsibility of administration and academia of universities to benefit from schemes of HEC like scholarships for Ph D, Indigenous Ph D program, Foreign Faculty Hiring, Student/Faculty exchange programme etc. He proposed that each university should choose at least one discipline for excellence. He said that the academia has better understanding of their problems and they can come up with adequate solutions.



Owais Ghani Chairs meeting of CC reiterating Universities to benefit from HEC Schemes

"One objective of this council is to provide a platform for interaction among the academia. Meet with each other, discuss the plans for promotion of higher education and then apprise me of your deliberations, I will do every thing possible to get your proposals approved at highest level" he remarked. It is not too late; we can start from small things and reach at the highest level of excellence. Start with immediate problems for example shortage of faculty, prepare proposals in the light of schemes of HEC like foreign faculty hiring and send these proposals to HEC. He said that there are at least 22 programmes of HEC in the domains of Social Sciences, curriculum development, grooming of young scientists, post-graduate and post-doctoral schemes and merit scholarships we can get benefit from. Faculty development should be at the top of our priority list.

"We have to be ambitious aiming at highest targets. We can engage Pakistani Professors working in U.S.A and other advanced countries under foreign Faculty Hiring Scheme. Explore these schemes and keep me updated. Identify the people from Pakistan and abroad then we will contact the HEC for hiring them. Meet me frequently at least once every fortnight. I have discussed all aspects of higher education with Dr Atta-ur-Rehman in reference to Balochistan. He is very considerate in this respect".

Dr. Mohammad Abbas Choudhary, Vice Chancellor Balochistan University of Information Technology & Management Sciences, proposed a two-phase plan. Phase-I for short term objectives (duration two years) and the Phase-II for long term objectives (duration five years). He also mentioned a seminar aimed at faculty development on Data-communication and scheduled on 26-27 September 2003 at BUITMS in collaboration with HEC. Funding for this seminar was received from HEC within one week from date of submission of the proposal.

Vice Chancellor BUITMS proposed II phase plan, epitomizing the cherished objectives of Chancellor

The Honourable Governor said that using HEC scheme, we can hire faculty from Pakistan and abroad and train our junior teachers. Dr. Mohammad Abbas Choudhary mentioned that BUITMS has initiated programs for which faculty from Karachi, Lahore and



Islamabad come to Quetta twice a month. Dr. Mohammad Hussain. Dean Faculty of Management Sciences, said that we have to augment our resources and utilize these optimally. Public sector universities of Balochistan should have joint supervisory committee for M Phil and PhD programs, a student exchange program and inter library loan scheme should be started for students of these universities. It was remarked that each of public sector universities of Balochistan should have training facilities in at least one particular discipline.

A member of council mentioned that GRE is a pre requisite for PhD Program. The Governor proposed that the potential candidates of Ph D should be trained for GRE test. Relaxation of age and condition of first division for Ph D candidature was also discussed.

BUITMS wins first two positions in ITAP Software Exhibition



Secretary I.T says BUITMS heralds success for the Province of Balochistan now and for times to come


