

At the end of the function, prizes were distributed amongst the winners and the position holders.




5th Staff Development Program under NAHE

PARTICIPATION IN LUMS INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON MATHEMATICS

LUMS is one of the most prestigious institutions of higher learning in Pakistan. Although they started as a top grade University of Management Sciences, they are gradually extending their fields of interest, and have developed a Mathematics Department which not only excels in teaching and supervising at Post-Graduate level but is also involved in hectic research activities of the highest standard. Thus they have been arranging Mathematics conferences for the past several years, and gathering mathematicians from all over Pakistan and enabling them to interact with each



other. They have now widened their scope and held LUMS International Conference on Mathematics, from 27th to 30th November, 2005.

The Mathematics Department of BUITMS eagerly participates and plays a frontline role in research activities held anywhere in Pakistan. It, therefore, sent two Professors Dr. Muhammad Nawaz and Dr. Ansaruddin Syed to the Conference. They took part in the proceedings of the Conference, interacted with the Mathematicians present and presented their own research papers. The topic of Dr. Nawaz's paper was Brouwerian Algebra and Paraconsistent Logic and discussed the valuation system for intuitionistic logic and paraconsistent logic. Dr. Syed talked about the Representation Theory of Lie Groups used in Physics, and pointed out certain important differences in the behaviour of rotation groups and affine groups.

Brouwerian Algebras & Paraconsistent logic by Dr. M. Nawaz, Dean Faculty of Computer & Emerging Sciences.

Abstract of paper:



We consider lattices which admit certain binary operations that force distributivity. One such lattice is Boolean algebra for which the binary operation is induced by an endofunction which turns out to be the

negation for the Boolean algebra. These binary operations and corresponding implications and negations for Heyting algebras and Browerian algebras, are discussed in detail. Boolean algebra is well known to serve as valuation system for classical logic while Heyting algebra and Brouwerian algebra are valuation systems for intuitionistic logic and paraconsistent logic respectively. At the end we give a necessary and sufficient condition for a lattice to be a Boolean algebra.

Some Remarks on Difference in Behaviour
Of Rotation Group & Affine Group by
Dr. Ansaruddin Syed
Department Of Mathematics

Abstract of paper:

It is a well known fact that the matrix $R(\theta)$ of rotations in R2 can be obtained from the generator J of infinitesimal rotations by the formula $R(\theta)=\exp(J\theta)$

while no such formula for an affine transformation $g(\alpha 1, \alpha 2)$, given by



 $G(\alpha_1, \alpha_2)x = \alpha_1x + \alpha_2$, exists. Similarly, although the Lie Algebra of, say, the rotation group SO(3), can be realised by the infinitesimal generators J1, J2, J3, themselves, we have to go to the action of group elements

on FUNCTIONS of x, to generate the Lie Algebra of the affine group. In the present paper, we analyse this difference in behaviour of these groups (rotation and affine) and show that it arises basically due to the fact that group elements satisfy DIFFERENT differential equations in the two cases.


INAUGURATION OF THE NEW JUMBO SHUTTLES

Mr. Shahwani did his M.Sc. (Hons) Agriculture from SAU Tando jam. His M.Sc (Hons) research work was on "Combining ability and Heterosis studies of different maize crosses. In 1995, Balochistan Public Service Commission selected him for the post of Agriculture Officer B-17 on merit. He pioneered Plant Tissue Culture Laboratory at Agriculture Research Institute Sariab Quetta. He established and operated a well organized Plant Tissue Culture lab and succeeded in the production of hundreds of invitro plants of potatoes, roses, straw berries and thuja etc. Beside this he also did a considerable research and developmental work on the promotion of True Potato Seed (TPS) and Olive cultivation in Balochistan. He has seven research papers to his credit published in famous National Scientific Journals. He joined the Faculty of Biotechnology and Management sciences in Dec 2004 as Assistant Professor of agriculture and tissue Culture. He is working on establishing the plant tissue culture facilities to combat problems like drought conditions, low yield and inferior quality agricultural products.

His current research interests are the identification of protein and molecular markers of drought and salt tolerant oilseed crops with special emphasis on clives and canola.
