- 2. Gender empowerment for Socio Economic Development
- 3. Voluntarism in Natural Disasters: Challenges and Strategies

The convention commenced with the recitation of verses from the Holy Quran by Hafiz Muhamad Idrees of MBA-3A. Ms. Sahar Faiz Khan of BS (Economics) 2nd semester had the privilege of reciting a Naat on the occasion.

The topic "Pakistan My Identity" fetched two pronged response from the student speakers. Many asserted that since we had failed as a nation and were divided in ethnicities, castes and

Provinces, therefore, no identity of a nation or homeland as one united unit existed in Pakistan. The others, nonetheless, emphasized that our identity was solely Pakistan and any conflicts within the country should be taken as mere misunderstandings among people of one family. "Silent majority believes in one



united identity i.e. identity of being a Pakistani, nothing else. The false perception that provincialism and nationalism have taken lead over Pakistanism is but an intrigue designed and propagated by vested interests; mainly the so called think tanks who only think what they are funded to! Let me ask them why people of all provinces and nations feel pride when Arfa Karim becomes the youngest Microsoft certified programmer and Pakistan yes Pakistan is declared as the land of genius? Why people of all provinces and nations are equally touchy about defeat & victory of Pakistan cricket team? Why people of all provinces and nations come up with such unprecedented response that even motorway observed traffic jam while earth quake occurred in only one part of the country?" argued one speaker.

Unanimity of views existed on the topic regarding gender empowerment. Speakers maintained that progress in any field would be impossible until and unless both wings of society i.e. male and female work together and complement each others efforts. "Stark difference between developed and underdeveloped countries is that developed countries have a positive rather healthy ratio of coordination between genders that has worked wonders to their socio-economic development" one of the speakers observed.

Students speaking on "Voluntarism in Natural Disasters" remarked that the growing incidence of natural disasters throughout the world called for special emphasis on voluntarism so that the whole nation comes up to assist relief agencies in case any disaster takes place. The outstanding work done by volunteers after Tsunami and October-8 quake was also highlighted in this regard.

7th Free IT Awareness Program at BUITMS

Surviving in the new era of 21st century requires some high efficiency and talent, and if you have good computer skills it can play a vital role in your career. But in Balochistan the rate of computer literacy is very low and The Government of Balochistan is trying its best to spread computer literacy all over Balochistan so that Balochistan can stand with other provinces of Pakistan in the field of IT.

With the aim and commitment of spreading computer literacy all over the province the Balochistan University of Information Technology and Management Sciences arranged the 7th Free IT Awareness Program from 15th February to 3rd of March, 2006. This program was simultaneously conducted at the city campus as well as at the Takatu Campus of BUITMS; this program was conducted with the help of those chosen regular University students who had good results in their department.

A total of 700 individuals, including people from different walks of life benefited from the program this time. Their age and gender wise break up provides interesting clues to the popular trends of future educational approaches. The learner's group comprised 597 males and 103 females. Among them were 100 boys and 30 girls below the age of 15, while 497 men and 70 women, including doctors, college teachers, engineers, journalist, shopkeepers etc took the opportunity of acquiring basic and advanced computer skills.

This indicates that both our youths and grown up are fast realizing the importance of IT for moving upward in all professional spheres. Students diligently conducted the courses according to the intellectual level of the participants and focused on the individual needs.

The initiative taken by the Government in collaboration with UNESCO will help to develop quality manpower in IT sector through "IT Forum" for the province of Balochistan. 
Biotech International Forum at Lahore

BINASIA and Pakistan National Workshop & Lahore Bioforum 2006 were jointly organized by the National Centre of Excellence in Molecular Biology, University of Punjab, the Federal Ministry of Education and the Federal Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of Pakistan from 11-12 March & 13-15 March 2006 respectively.





A delegation from the Faculty of Biotechnology & Informatics, BUITMS, Quetta also participated in BINASIA & Lahore Bioforum2006. The delegation from BUITMS was headed by Prof. Dr. M.A.K. Malghani Dean Faculty of Biotechnology & Informatics and included three other faculty members, Dr Shaukat Iqbal Malik, Miss Sarwat Afridi & Miss Bushra Batool





The objectives of BINASIA

Pakistan National workshop were to share the work done on Biotechnology by various research institutes within Asian countries and to promote collaboration in research and commercialization of the products. Renowned institutes like Quaid i-Azam University Islamabad, NIBGE Faisalabad, IBGE Peshawar, MICROB University of Karachi, IBB Lahore & BUITMS, Quetta played their proactive roles in the success of the events, as most of the institutions presented their research works. From BUITMS, Dean of Faculty of Biotechnology & Informatics Prof. Dr. M. A. K. Malghani presented a report on the ongoing research projects and Dr. Shaukat Iqbal Malik presented his work on cytogenetics.

Lahore Bioforum 2006 was held from 13th -15th March 2006. In this Bioforum pharmaceutical companies were provided opportunities to promote the marketing of the products developed by the different institutions. All the institutions exhibited their products on stalls. The Faculty of Biotechnology & Informatics had their stall where 5 products were exhibited:

1: Algamino (Organic)

Seaweed Extract (18%) + Amino acid (10%)

Algamino is extracted from algae formulated with Amino acid. It is a non-toxic, harmless extraction which replenishes the organic nutrition, promotes balanced growth, increases fertility, raises the capacity of resistance of plants to improve crop quality and increases the crop yield

2: Taraxan

(Organic root growth Promoter)

(47% Taraxicum, Cnicus, Astragullus and valerian Extract)

Taraxan is extracted from four different herbs. It promotes root growth and enhances the seed



germination and ultimately increases yield and quality of any crop.

3: Agro-tonic

(Macro and Micro nutrients

Agro-tonic is formulated for the crops which need quick availability of m\macro and micro nutrient during their crucial growth period. It contains all the 13 elements needed for the plant growth in a balanced form.

4: Zatoran 5EC

(Ai: 5% Inert: 95%)

Zatoran is one of the safest miticides formulated by the utilization of an indigenous herb (Zatoria multiflora). It is formulated with non hazardous inert material. It is so safe that human can directly consume it for the treatment chest infections.

5: Anatural Product "Chiltano"

Prepared from Algae as an anti-aging supplement. In addition to some proteins, it contains essential oils and coenzymes.

Some of the products were prepared with the collaboration of PCSIR Laboratories, Quetta.

The visit proved to be very successful because many pharmaceutical companies showed their interest in marketing of above mentioned products.

Strengthening further Bilateral Relations between Pak & Iran

Governor Balochistan Owais Ahmed Ghani was on a three-day official visit to Islamic Republic of Iran. The visit that turned out to be a very hectic was equally a significant in certain ways especially when it comes to talking about its outcome in terms of signing some Memoranding (MoU) between the two provinces of Iran (Seistan and Balochistan) and Pakistan

(Balochistan) for boosting cooperation in various fields including trade, energy, education and other sectors.

The Governor's visit was also significant particularly in respect of its coincidence with the US President's visit to the South Asian countries including India and Pakistan, besides Afghanistan and when there are serious threats to Iran owing to its N-capability issue. Pakistan, in this particular situation, is determined to bolster the mutual cooperation with brotherly

country Iran in various sectors.

It is worth mentioning that Mr. Owais Ahmed Ghani was the first Governor of Balochistan, who visited Iran since the Iranian Islamic revolution some 22 years ago.

Governor General of Seistan-Balochistan Dr. Habibullah Dahmardah and other Iranian high ups were among those who received the delegation at the Zahidan airport.

The Governor's delegation, which took part in the wide ranging talks with the Iranian authorities comprised the Consul General of Pakistan in Zahidan Mr. Khalid Javed, Chief Executive QESCO Brigadier Tasadduq Hussain Shah, Collector Pakistan Customs Quetta, Mr. Muhammad Yahya, Vice Chancellor Balochistan University of Information Technology and Management Sciences (BUITMS) Dr. Muhammad Abbas Choudhary, Vice Chancellor of University of Balochistan Ghulam Muhammad Taj, , a representative of Frontier Corps (FC) Colonel Zafar Saleem and some officials from the Pakistani consulate.



During the visit, the two provincial authorities decided to further enhance already existing brotherly and friendly relations between the two countries, on behalf of their respective countries.

An MoU to this was effect was also signed by the Balochistan Governor Owais Ahmed Ghani and Governor Seistan-Balochistan Dr. Habibullah Dahmardeh at a historic meeting in Zabul (Iran).

Under the MoU, it was decided that exchange of high level delegations between Balochistan and Seistan would be enhanced and meetings and talks between the officials of the two provinces or Iran and Pakistan would be continued.

About promotion of economic cooperation it was stressed that trade volume between the two countries would be increased and steps would be taken for achieving target of one billion dollars annually.

It was further decided to improve rail link between the two countries while problems of drivers and transporters would be resolved through Joint Road Transportation Committee. Matter of reduction in customs duty would also be reviewed and anti smuggling steps and promotion of legal trade would also be taken.

The abstract of paper is-

As Web is a huge resource repository, due to which growth of dynamic Web page generation techniques, the amount and the complexity of Web information has been increasing explosively, as has the information contained within Web pages. Most of the unstructured and irrelevant information is distributed and mixed throughout a page, making it difficult to automatically drive the user for Web information (context-based) browsing, it is also difficult to identify the useful information in that page specified to the user context. We propose the dynamic Web information adaptation framework in this paper, using the framework; we can extract the significance and the relationship value of information contained with in a Web page in accordance with the user's context, the track of the user context will also be maintained in order to facilitate him/her with more useful information using web mining agents. This framework can be used to generate new dynamic Web information structure for the browsing process. Our context-based dynamic information adaptation framework transforms the information in a new Web information structure using the context-aware information generation process by applying the Ontologies of Web pages to build the new information structure, the Agents are used to collect and mine the Web context information.

A PROJECT LEADING TO EMERGING TECHNOLOGIES



The objective behind the implementation of cluster computing project in BUITMS at Takatu Campus is to provide a baseline for the enhancement of research work in the field of latest research and emerging technologies.

A cluster is a group of individual computer systems that can be made to function as a single computer system. There are two primary types of systems that make up a cluster-Nodes and Managers (Server). The cluster manager is the core of the cluster. It determines how work is to be divided among the cluster nodes. The cluster manager distributes the workload to each cluster node. The cluster node then processes the job. After processing it either sends the result back to the cluster manager or directly to the client that requested the result. There are two types of clusters, Data cluster and computational cluster. Computational cluster manages the sharing of distributed computational power while data cluster manages the sharing of distributed storage. (Like Real Application Clusters in Oracle 10g).



Key Advantages of cluster for BUITMS

As BUITMS is one of the rapid growing Public Sector Universities and very soon its student's strength is likely to rise significantly, it will become very difficult to manage the university data by a sole computer. Moreover different research tasks related to BUITMS Departments like Gnome, Image Processing, Image Rendering, Neural Networks and Data Mining Algorithms etc can be accomplished using the cluster environment.

It is honor for Computer Science Department and BUITMS that my research paper with title "PCA based Image Classification of Single-layered Cloud Types" has published in IEEE---2005 International Conference on Emerging Technologies (ICET-2005),

September 17-18, 2005 Islamabad.

The abstract of paper is-

The paper presents an automatic classification system, which discriminates the different types of single-layered clouds using Principal Component Analysis (PCA) with enhanced accuracy as compared to other techniques. PCA is an image classification technique typically used for face recognition. Principal components are the distinctive or peculiar features of an image. The approach described in this paper uses this PCA capability for enhancing the accuracy of cloud image analysis. To demonstrate this enhancement, a software classifier system has been developed that incorporates PCA capability for better discrimination of cloud images.

The system is first trained using cloud images. In training phase, system reads major principal features of the different cloud images to produce an image space. In testing phase, a new cloud image can be classified by comparing it with the specified image space using the PCA algorithm.

Financial Management Course for **Engineers and Technocrats**

Balochistan University of Information Technology & Management Sciences sent Mr. Abdul Raziq Lecturer Faculty of Management Sciences to attend a 3- day(1st, 2nd and 3rd Feb, 2006) postgraduate short course on: Financial Management For Engineers And Technocrats, which was organized by NED University of Engineering & Technology, Karachi, the Center For Continuing Engineering Education. This course was designed to provide an understanding of the key concepts in finance and blends broad financial principles with the engineering profession to help engineers and managers make effective and timely decision. Managers and Engineers from different corporate sectors participated in this short course. The trainers were Engr. Amir Bashir: BE (NED), CFA level 1, CFA institute USA and Mr. Yosuf khan: MBA (IBA) Master trainer (LUMS-McGill, Canada).

This short course was comprised of three full day sessions. The topics covered on day 1(from 9:30 1:00) were financial accounting and statements, the accounting equation, balance sheet, income statement, cash flow statement, statement of retained earnings. From 2:00- 4:30 finance as a function of business, the objective of financial management, financial control, budgeting, zero- base budgeting, cash budgeting, inventory control. On day 2 (from 9:30 1:00) business cycle, working capital management, working capital management & financing decision. From 2:00- 4:30 capitalization Vs. expensing, impact on financial statements due to capitalization vs. expensing. On day 3 (from 9:30 1:00) time value of money, simple interest and compound interest, present and future values, compounding of series payments, valuation models. Decision making financial tools for project financing, project cash flow analysis. From 2: 30 4:30 computer lab- excel based project decision making financial tools & various parameters through leasing financing schedule.

On the final day the chief guest (Dean Faculty of Computer & Emerging Sciences NED University of Engineering & Technology) distributed the certificates among the participants
